SECTION 8 RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Section 8 programs pay subsidies directly to owners of private rental dwellings on behalf of low-income families. Applicants must meet federal eligibility guidelines. Dwellings must pass inspection based on Department of Housing and Urban Development Housing Quality Standards and local housing codes. Applicants may remain in their present housing or move to another location that meets program standards.

Low-interest homeownership loans are available to low and moderate income persons to purchase renovated homes in the City of Hagerstown. Applicants must meet income guidelines, have good or improving credit record, and not currently own a home. Applicants pay a \$500 down payment, with the remaining purchase price and closing costs included in the loan.

Habitat is a non-profit organization that builds houses using volunteer labor and donated materials and sells them at no interest to low-income families. Habitat seeks families living in sub-standard conditions (lack of proper plumbing or wiring, other structural problems, overcrowding conditions or dangerous neighborhoods). To qualify, applicants must meet income guidelines, be ineligible for normal mortgage loans, yet be able to pay for their home. Habitat homeowners must be willing to partner with Habitat, which includes performing 500 hours of sweat equity (work on at least their own homes, and homes of others, until hours fulfilled).
